Text: 2 Peter 3: 11-12

¹¹ Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner *of persons* ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, ¹² looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat?

Dissolve : *luo –* unravel, loosen, unbind

Early Church – Persecuted & Suffered By own kin – Pharisees & Sadducees By the Roman authorities – made scapegoats Paul – warned, misunderstood, betrayed, locked up, house arrest, imprisoned, executed (67-68 AD?) Jerusalem – sacked in 70 AD; items to Rome But gospel travelled extensively !

The Resurrection Affirmations

- Apostolic teaching -disturbed the Jewish leaders, esp the Sadducees (Acts 4:2)
- Witnesses of the event (Acts 5:30-32)
- Central to Christian faith (1 Cor. 15:17)
- Power for daily life and ministry (Eph 1:18-20)
- Death conquered (2Tim1:10; John 11:25-26)
- Living hope (1 Pet. 1:3)
- Mission to the lost (Matt. 28: 18-19)

<u>The manner of persons we ought to be</u> Vastly different world after this – no restoration Accept as process of God's event chronology Shakings & refining of His people (Heb.12:25-27) Awakening to essentials (1 Pet. 1:6-7) * Live the resurrection life (Gal. 2:20) Redeeming mission opportunities (2 Pet 3:9)
